

2026/2027 Chinese Government Scholarship Application

The 2026/2027 Chinese Government Scholarship is now open for application. Online application (www.campuschina.org) should be submitted no later than March 20, 2026. After your application, please send the application form and digital copy of required documents to the Chinese Embassy (nauruan5541241@gmail.com) and Department of Education of Nauru.

Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must

- be a citizen of the Republic of Nauru, and be in good health both mentally and physically.
- be a high school graduate under the age of 25 when applying for undergraduate programs;
- be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for master's programs;
- be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for doctoral programs;
- be a high school graduate (at least) under the age of 45 when applying for general scholar programs;
- be a master's degree holder or an associate professor (or above) under the age of 50 when applying for senior scholar programs.
- **take the "China Scholastic Competency Assessment (short as CSCA)" and upload a valid score report when applying for bachelor programs. <https://csc.cn/home>**
- have acquired the Chinese proficiency of HSK Level 3 when applying for Chinese-taught undergraduate or general scholar programs (studying Chinese language are exempted);
- have acquired the Chinese proficiency of HSK Level 3 when applying for Chinese-taught senior scholar programs;
- have acquired the Chinese proficiency of HSK Level 4 when applying for Chinese-taught master's or doctoral programs;

- meet the admission requirements of the applied universities in terms of academic ability, language proficiency and other relevant criteria.

Application Documents

a) Application Form (in Chinese or English): The Application Form will be created automatically after the correct filling through Chinese Government Scholarship Information System (CGSIS). Instructions of the online application is in the next chapter.

b) Passport Home Page: Applicants are required to submit a clear scanned copy of the information page of their ordinary passports. If the validity period of the currently held passport is less than 12 months (calculated from the expected start date of study), please renew the passport and use it to complete the scholarship application. An applicant who fails to apply for a passport due to objective reasons may submit valid documentation or documentary evidence that carries information about the full English name, gender, nationality and date of birth of the applicant upon the approval of the application receiving agency;

c) Notarized highest diploma: Prospective diploma winners must submit official proof of student status by their current school. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

d) Academic transcripts: Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

e) Language qualification certificates. Applicants for master's, doctoral, general scholar, and senior scholar programs taught in Chinese must submit a valid HSK score report that meets the corresponding Chinese language proficiency requirements. Applicants for programs taught in other languages are required to provide relevant language proficiency certificates, such as IELTS or TOEFL score reports, in accordance with the requirements of each university.

f) CSCA Score Report. Applicants seeking to pursue a bachelor's degree must register for and take the CSCA before the application deadline, and obtain a valid Score Report. Please contact the target institution to inquire about and obtain the required test subjects for the applied major. Applicants intending to enroll in September 2026 are required to register for and take the CSCA on March 15, 2026.

g)Pre-Admission Documents. All applicants must provide a pre-admission document issued by the universities applying. Pre-admission documents include pre-admission notice issued by the international students' admission department or invitation letter from the schools or professors, etc.

h) A Study Plan or Research Proposal in Chinese or English. (A minimum of 200 words for undergraduates, 500 words for non-degree students, and 800 words for postgraduates.)

i) Recommendation letters: Applicants for graduate programs or senior scholar programs must submit two letters of recommendation in Chinese or English from professors or associate professors.

J) Example of Art. To apply for art or design related majors, applicants could submit their own works through "Example of Art/Other Supporting Documents" in the system. Applicants could also provide such materials to the applied universities directly in other ways.

k) Applicants under the age of 18 should submit the valid documents of their legal guardians in China(can be the Embassy of Nauru in China).

l) Applicants planning to stay in China for more than 6 months must submit a photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form completed in English (the original copy should be kept by the applicant. The form is designed by the Chinese quarantine authority and can be obtained from the dispatching authority. The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the

applicants are invalid. Please select the appropriate time to take physical examination as the result is valid for only 6 months.

m) Non-criminal record report. The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued by the local public security authority, usually issued within 6 months prior to the submission date of the application.

Reminder: Uploaded supporting documents must be clear, authentic and valid. Applicants are recommended to use professional device to scan the relevant documents. Applicants shall bear the consequences caused by unclear or unidentifiable uploaded materials.

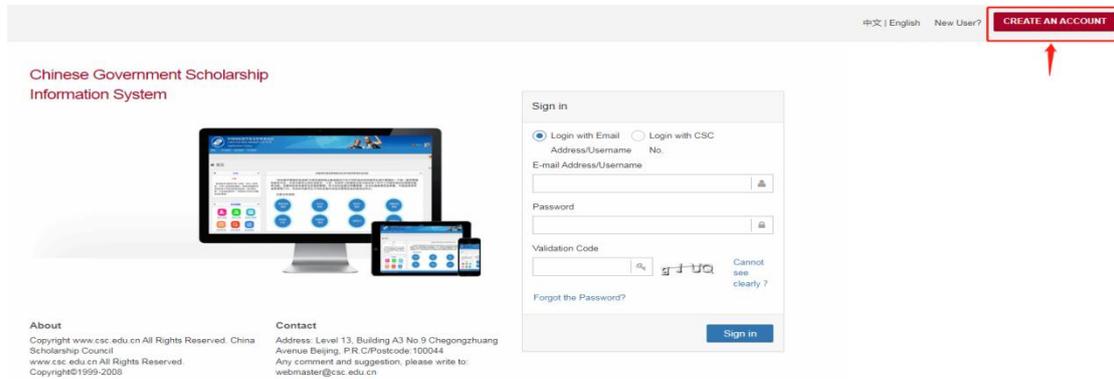

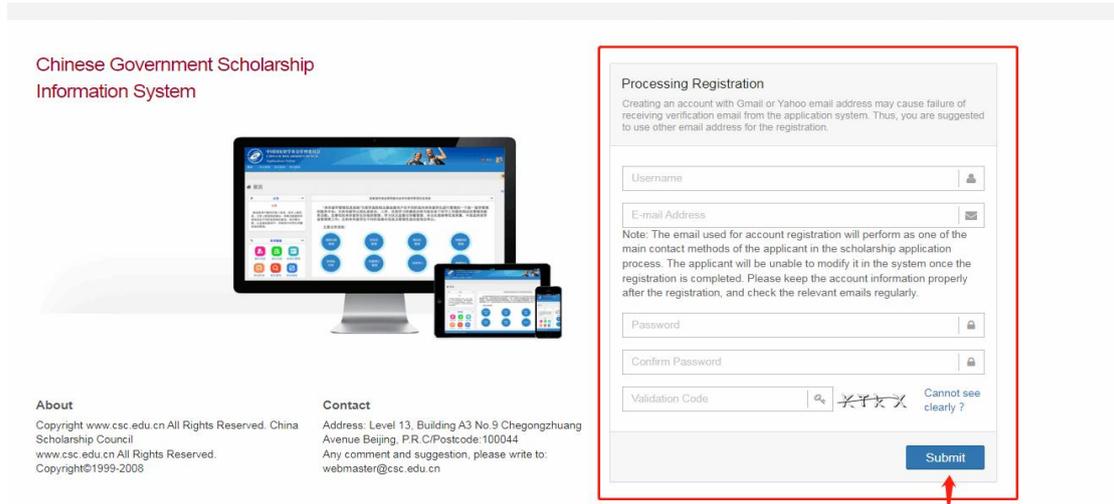

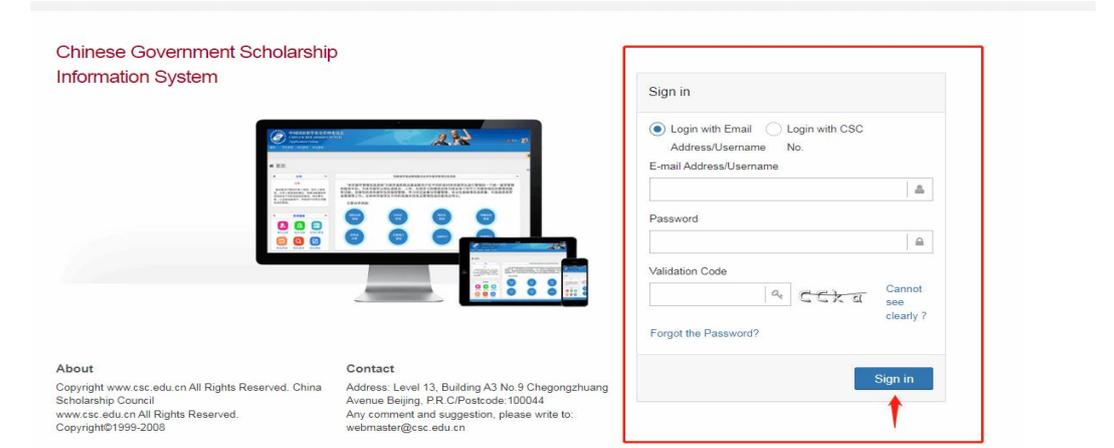

Please carefully read the instructions before applying for the scholarship. Then start application by clicking "Application Online".

Step 1: Input Personal Details. Click "Edit Personal Details" and finish inputting personal details by filling in all the information, verifying and saving the information. After the completion of this section, return to the previous page by clicking "Finish" and start filling in your application information.

Step 2: Select the correct "Program Category".

- **Program Category Type A** generally refers to scholarship programs responsible by authorities except Chinese universities. Applicants of Type A programs **Number** of relevant agencies (e.g. Chinese Embassy in your country). Applications of Type A will be reviewed by these agencies.
- **Program Category Type B** generally refers to scholarship programs responsible by Chinese universities under CGS-Chinese University Program. Applicants of Type B will be reviewed by the applied universities.
- **Program Category Type C** generally refers to certain appraisal scholarship programs. Applicants of Type C programs will be informed by CSC of the **Agency**.

Step 3: Input the correct Agency Number, Program Category and Agency Number are directly matched, both are mandatory for online application. Scholarship application processing authorities will inform the program category and agency number to candidates who are qualified for applying. After inputting agency number, the matched agency name will automatically show on the page. As **Program Category** and **Agency Number** are directly matched, authorities will not receive your online application if the program category or agency number are not correct.

Step 4: Input Application Information.

For applicants who selected "Type A" and "Type C" application, move on to the section of "Language Proficiency and Study Plan" and upload "Supporting Documents" to complete the application.

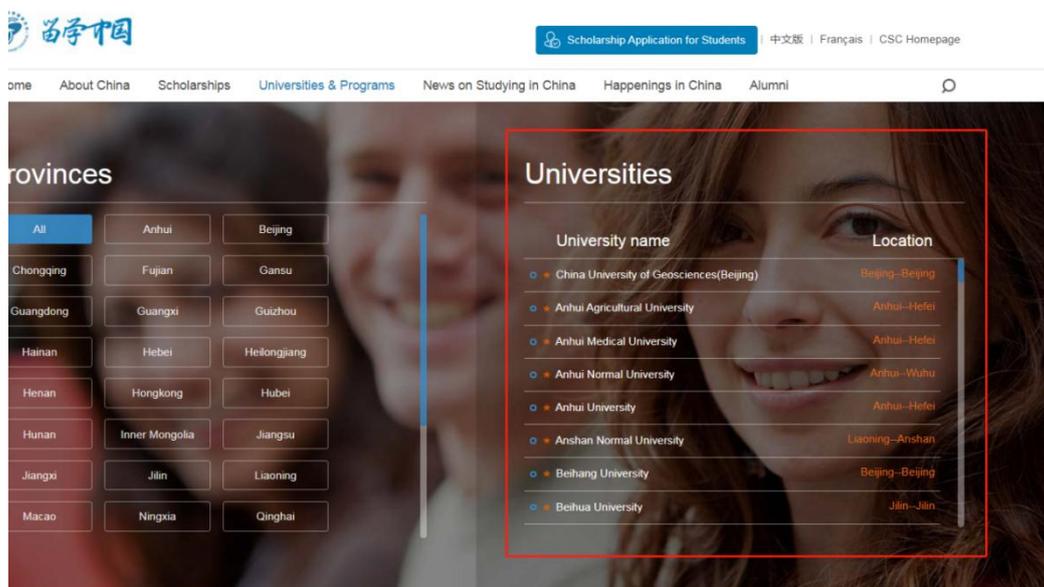

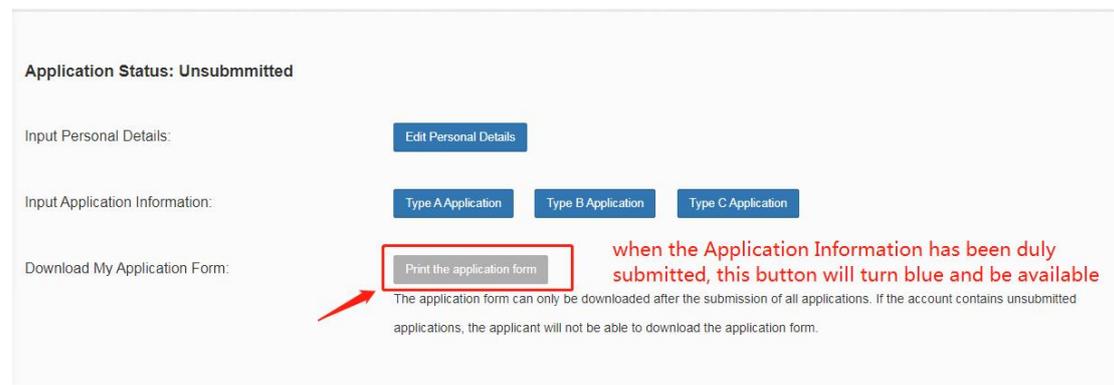

Time Frames

- Before March 20, 2026

Applicants submit their online application.

- March 20, 2026

The Chinese Embassy will examine the application forms and supporting documents. After that, the Embassy will send all recommended applications to China Scholarship Council for review.

- Late July or early August, 2026

China Scholarship Council confirm the candidates' applications and send admission letters to the Embassy. Scholarship winners will get the admission letters by emails and get JW201 visa forms at the Embassy.
